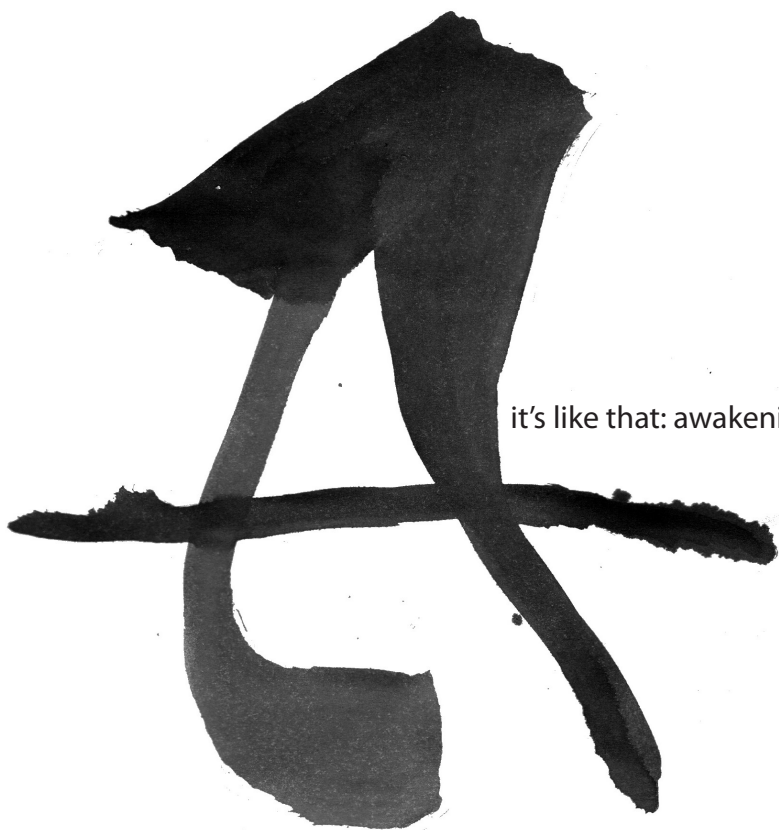

it's like that: awakening is an animal



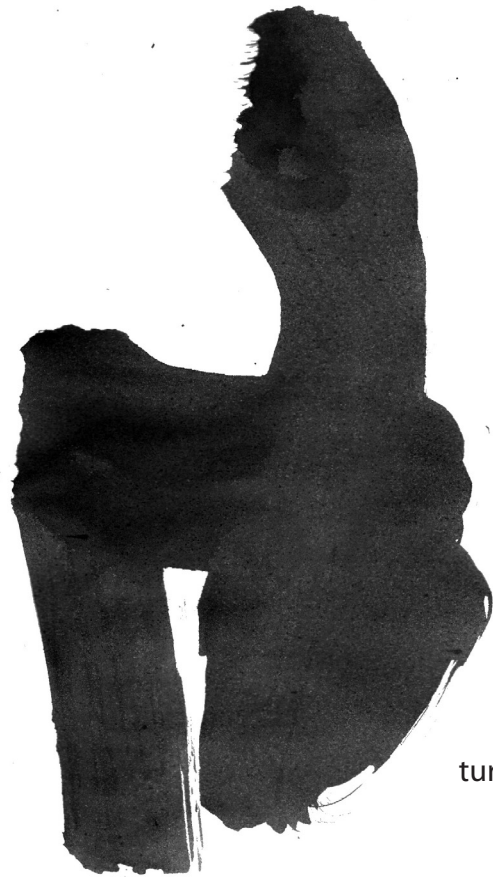
shining she breaks into the vending machine for a new leg

outside Breton's smokers still talk about le paysage

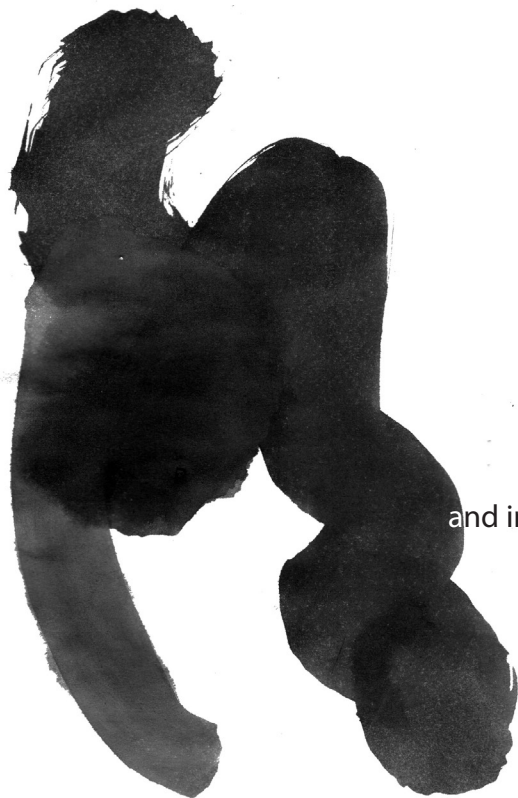


turning a corner he lets his blood out and creates the sky





before reaching Venezia a leaf becomes edible



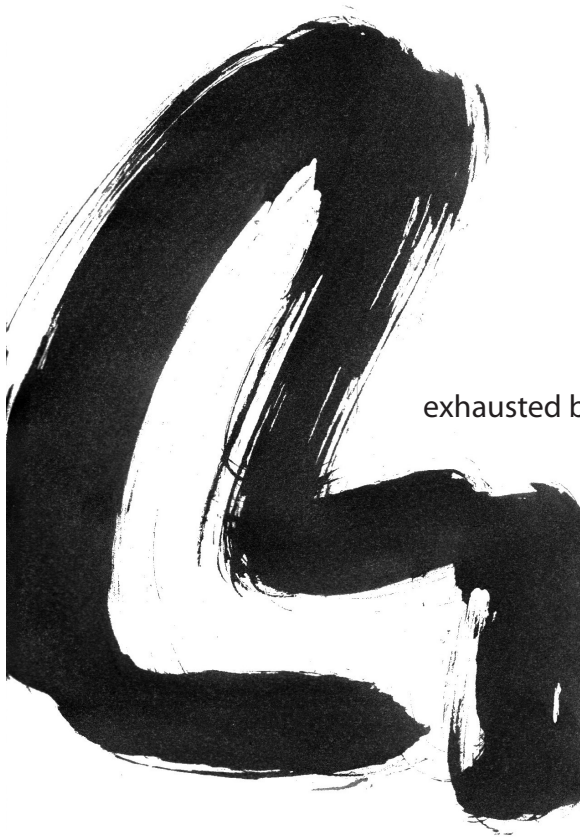
and in writing we lament our imagined past as shiny beetles



sometimes it's the swans sometimes the blue pills solidifying dusk



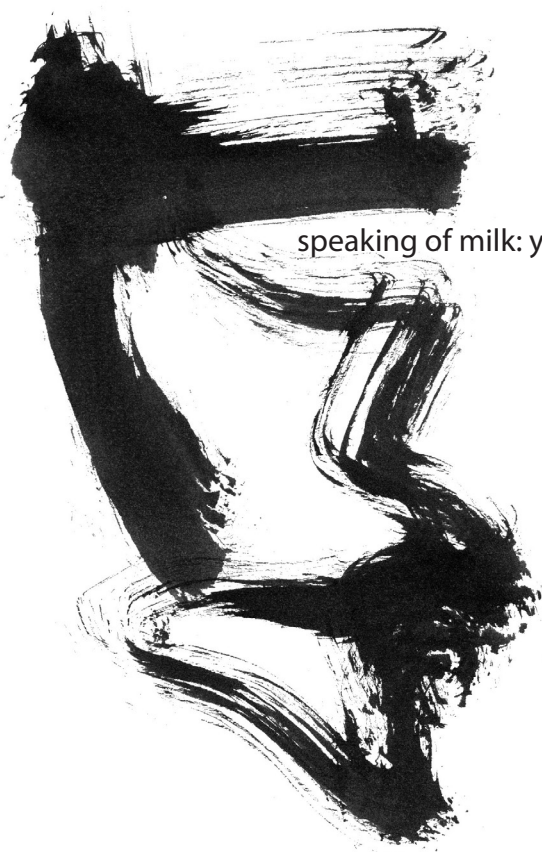
when dissecting your self put it on an old newspaper just in case
